

# Arts Impact

**Arts Impact** instructs PreK-8 classroom teachers in the foundational concepts of the arts (year one) and how to integrate them with CCSS Math and English Language Arts and NGSS STEM (year two). This two-year professional development includes a week-long summer institute each year, followed with a mentorship in the classroom. \$2175 per year, per teacher

Reading Infusion	Project-based Learning
Writing Infusion	Social Emotional Learning



**Arts Fundamentals** is a K-5 drawing and design residency that teaches the elements of art and principles of design, as well as close observation, drafting, reflecting, and revising. Students engage with a wide range of media to practice 21<sup>st</sup> Century Skills and learn how to express ideas visually. \$1,500 per teacher

**Using Theater to Build Empathy** Schools have an important role to play in providing stability and a safe space for children who have experienced trauma. This program trains K-8 educators to use theater in their everyday classroom experience to better meet the educational needs of students who have faced trauma. Exercises support Olweus and other anti-bullying, social justice curricula.

Option 1: a 3-hour workshop \$875

Option 2: a 6-hour workshop \$1250

Option 3: Option 1 or 2, *plus* residency\* of \$130 per classroom visit

\*number of residency visits are determined by the school's needs



**EcoArts** residency provides learning for PreK-5 students to infuse visual arts and environmental science. Students learn about the five R's (Reduce, Reuse, Recycle, Respect, and Responsibility) and make high quality art projects using recycled materials. \$850 per teacher



**Workshops and Residencies** in visual arts, dance, and theater (or all three) are also available, catered to your school's individual budget and area of focus. Workshop cost: \$875 (up to 4 hours) and \$1,250 (up to 8 hours). Residency cost: \$130 per classroom visit

Three teacher minimum per school. Discounts given for whole school/whole district initiatives.
